

Nashville State's Industrial Process Control Technology Program Receives \$4,000 Local Donations

Chemours and Greg Martz, a Humphreys County resident and Nashville State Community College Foundation board member, recently each donated \$2,000 to support the College's Industrial Process Control Technology (IPCT) program.
