Chemours Johnsonville Employees Continue Giving Back To Their Community

A group of 11 maintenance employees joined forces to help local families affected by the Humphreys County 2021 flood on Monday and Tuesday, June 13-14. Using their mechanical and I&E expertise, the Chemours Johnsonville crew worked on many projects of reconstruction and repair throughout different homes in the Waverly area. Their work comprised of completing a wheelchair ramp, shoring walls, removing debris, installing drywall, laying baseboards, and completing several electrical projects within a two-day period during a Tennessee heat wave where temperatures reached the mid-90's. Nine families in the Waverly area were helped by this crew of dedicated and courageous volunteers. At least 509 homes in Humphreys County were impacted by the August 2021 flooding, of which 271 were completely destroyed.
